

Is my cat getting old?

A few simple questions to help you and understand your cat better

Cries or becomes aggressive when lifted or being handled			
Cries out for no apparent reason			
Plays less with toys and other animals

Is more reluctant to greet me or interact with me			
Is asleep more often or less active than normal			
Has changed its sleeping place (e.g. to the floor or low surfaces)			
Spends less time grooming			
Has a poor coat			
Has more accidents outside the litter tray			
Is drinking more water			
Is less interested in food			
Eats more than usual			
Is vomiting or has diarrhoea occasionally			
Has breathing difficulties on occasions (e.g. laboured breathing, breathing with open mouth)
